

Mrs. Sarah Halbrook Dies At Son's Home After Breaking Hip

Funeral services for Mrs. Sarah Halbrook, 96, one of Clinton's oldest residents, were held at 2 p. m. Tuesday at Mt. View Baptist Church near Formosa by Rev. T. J. Cowan of Heber Springs and Rev. J. L. Pruitt of Clinton.

Mrs. Halbrook died at the home of her son, C. C. Halbrook, about 7:15 a. m. Monday after suffering a broken hip in a fall about two weeks ago.

She was born in McNairy County, Tenn., the daughter of William and Letty Woolverton, and came to Arkansas in her youth. She had been a member of the Mt. View Baptist Church 81 years and was the last surviving charter member.

She is survived by two other sons, W. E. Halbrook of Scotland and C. B. Halbrook of Fisk, Mo.; 22 grandchildren and 35 great-grandchildren.

Pallbearers were Sherrill Halbrook, Will Halbrook, Jack Lack, Audie Poteet and Harry Woolverton. Burial was in Woolverton Cemetery with Coffman Funeral Home of Clinton in charge.
